Prior to joining our Group, Ms. Wong worked for Kidsland International Holdings Limited, a company listed on the Main Board of Stock Exchange (stock code: 2122) and its subsidiaries, which principally engaged in the retail and wholesale of toys and infant products, from February 2013 to February 2019 and she was responsible for the pre-IPO investment project and the IPO project of such company. She was appointed as one of the joint company secretaries of Kidsland International Holdings Limited from April 2017 to February 2019. She has been the director of Acebright International Limited, which principally engaged in provision of consultancy services on functions ranging from corporate finance, investor relations and corporate development and is a licensed trust or company service provider since November 2008 and the vice-president in debt capital markets of Sumitomo Mitsui Banking Corporation from March 2007 to July 2009.
